About the Opportunity:

London 2012 Ceremonies Ltd is seeking a highly experienced high end scenic construction company, with large sporting event experience broadcast to a wide audience, or equivalent. The successful company will be required to produce all the Victory Ceremony Podia in a cost effective and high production value manner.

Description The successful company will be required to produce around 21 Individual/ Small Team Victory Ceremony Podia and 7 Large Team Victory Ceremony Podia. They will also be required to produce approximately 5 victory ceremony presentation floor mats to the required specifications within a 6 month period from finalisation of designs. Production of the Victory Ceremony Podia shall also include working closely with the designers which will include identifying the most appropriate construction materials and producing prototypes of the Victory Ceremony Podia.

London 2012 Ceremonies Ltd will establish the specification for its Podia on finalisation of the design. Please note this is not part of this opportunity, the Royal College of Art have been briefed to generate the design and the successful company will be asked to work with the winning students to realise and adapt their designs.

The successful company will be provided with the following:

- Podium and floor mat designs and specifications: to be modelled with the active participation of the successful company's in-house 3D design team.

About the buyer's selection process:

The successful company, and its key individuals, will need to demonstrate a proven record in the construction of high end scenic construction and staging exquisitely finished to a required technical specification. In addition to applying for this opportunity by responding to these questions on CompeteFor, applicants will be required to provide a 40 page (maximum) document providing supporting evidence to their responses within 48 hours of being shortlisted from CompeteFor.

This should include:

- A short bio of your organisation.
- Supporting evidence to your responses on CompeteFor questions in the form of case studies demonstrating experience in this field.
- 3 examples of similar scenic construction projects the company have produced with technical specs in the last 5 years.
- Copies of your Diversity and Inclusion Policy, Health and Safety Policy and Social and Environmental Sustainability Policy.
