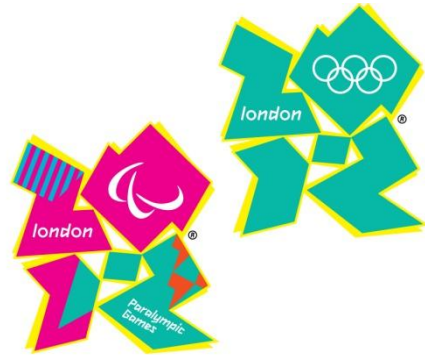

### **About the Opportunity:**

This opportunity is for an artist/arts organisation to deliver an integrated programme of arts-led community engagement for the developing memorial commission at Royal Artillery Barracks in Woolwich. Following a longlisting stage, a shortlist of suppliers will be interviewed and an appointed made by the end of March to deliver the project over the period April - September 2011. This programme will work in parallel and with students from Ravensbourne College developing their proposal for the memorial.

### **About the buyer's selection process:**

The Olympic Delivery Authority will award contracts to businesses that reflect London 2012's procurement policies and values. Value for money on costs, time, quality, design and functionality, the promotion of equality and diversity, environmental responsibility and legacy are key values that embody the ODA's procurement objectives.

Following shortlisting conducted on the CompeteFor system, you will be required to submit an Invitation to Quote (ITQ) directly to the ODA

project manager. You will be instructed further on this process following shortlisting.

During the procurement process suppliers may be required to provide supporting evidence within 24 hours, there may also be an additional stage added following shortlisting and prior to the quotation stage.

Post the Tender closing date, all suppliers will be notified of their status via email and will be able to view who the opportunity was awarded to.

The Olympic Delivery Authority (ODA) is the public body responsible for developing and building the new venues and infrastructure for the 2012 Olympic Games and their use after 2012.
