"The London Organising Committee of the Olympic and Paralympic Games (LOCOG), invites expressions of interest for the supply and installation of blackout curtains, privacy living room curtains, track way and commercial blinds for the Athletes' Village Stratford and the Sailing Village Portland & Weymouth apartments and town homes.

"Requirements: Curtains for 10,000 bedrooms and 3,000 living room spaces across two Olympic Villages. Commercial standard blinds are required for the Polyclinic (Athletes onsite medical centre- Stratford Village only) and Chobham Academy, including office / retail spaces with the apartment blocks. (Village operational spaces within the Stratford Village only). Bedroom Curtain Specifications: Black-out, basic design. Living Room Curtain Specifications: Standard basic design unlined, single colour. Track Specifications: Standard ceiling mounted. Commercial Standard Blinds: Amount and type TBC.

"Installation operations are required to commence from May 2011. Completion of operations December 2011 (TBC). Delivery and installation teams are required to complete site orientation for Athletes' Village Stratford and Sailing Village Weymouth respectively before commencing operations. There is also a requirement to submit to security checks for both materials and personnel before entry to either Village is permitted."
