About the Opportunity:

A Subcontractor/Subcontractors are required to carry out the installation of the lighting across the Olympic Park which has been split into two categories.

Category 1

Description

- The design, procurement, manufacture, supply and installation of bespoke lighting and proprietary lighting required on all the Olympic Park bridges and underpasses with the exception of a few structures. The design aspect will include full and residual design of the bespoke lighting. All bespoke luminaries will have to undergo appropriate independent testing to demonstrate compliance with the Bespoke Luminaries Performance Specification.

Category 2

- To carry out the procurement, supply and installation of proprietary lighting on the Loop Road. (Mainly columns and luminaries). A single source supplier has been nominated, from which the appointed subcontractor would have to obtain materials.

Due to the value of both works, a collateral warranty will be required. The selected subcontractor may also be required to

- hold stock of spares for all bespoke and proprietary units (not required for category 2)
- provide replacement luminaries to a maintenance contractor as necessary with damaged/faulty units returned to the manufacturer for repair so that they can be used as spares in the future

About the buyer's selection process:

In selecting a supplier/subcontractor, we take into consideration

- Compliance with and execution of Appendix B of the Code of Practice for Industrial Relations, Corporate Confidentiality Undertaking and Terms & Conditions for Construction Site Personnel, LOCOG deed and Collateral Warranty deed (where necessary).
